OUR COMMITMENT

Founded in 2016 in response to the high rates of early school leaving and youth unemployment in Spain, the Spanish Association of Second Chance Schools was created with the mission of providing concrete and effective solutions for young people in Spain who are unemployed and without qualifications. It does so through the development of a recognised national model of Second Chance Schools (E2O), innovative and well-established, closely linked to the business sector, and recognised and supported by public institutions.

Our vision is to achieve recognition of the E2O model as an essential element in the fight against early school leaving and youth unemployment, ensuring its coordination and complementarity with public policies.

Principles of the labelled E2O in Spain:

- *To have recognition from public authorities and operate in complementarity with their policies.*
- *To aim for the lasting social and professional integration of unemployed young people who are outside the education system.*
- *To develop their social and professional skills through innovative training characterized by flexible and individualized pathways.*
- *To maintain close collaboration with the business sector, prioritizing practical experience.*
- *Networking, strengthening cooperation among second chance schools and mobilizing organisations and public administrations in their environment.*

The success rate for the 2023–2024 academic year measures students' situation six months after leaving the E2O: whether they have entered the labour market or enrolled in formal or non-formal education at another institution.

E2O schools provide an effective educational response for young people who have faced difficulties in their regular academic path and continue to encounter challenges in obtaining a qualification, or who are at risk of social and/or labor exclusion.

The E2O accreditation process is audited by the independent entity EDUQATIA.

The Association has a policy for the protection of minors and individuals in vulnerable situations.

Labellisation E2O

- **27 people participated in the seventh training on the E2O labelling process, which took place in Madrid in September 2024, to learn about the process in detail and prepare for either the renewal or the first labelling of their school.**

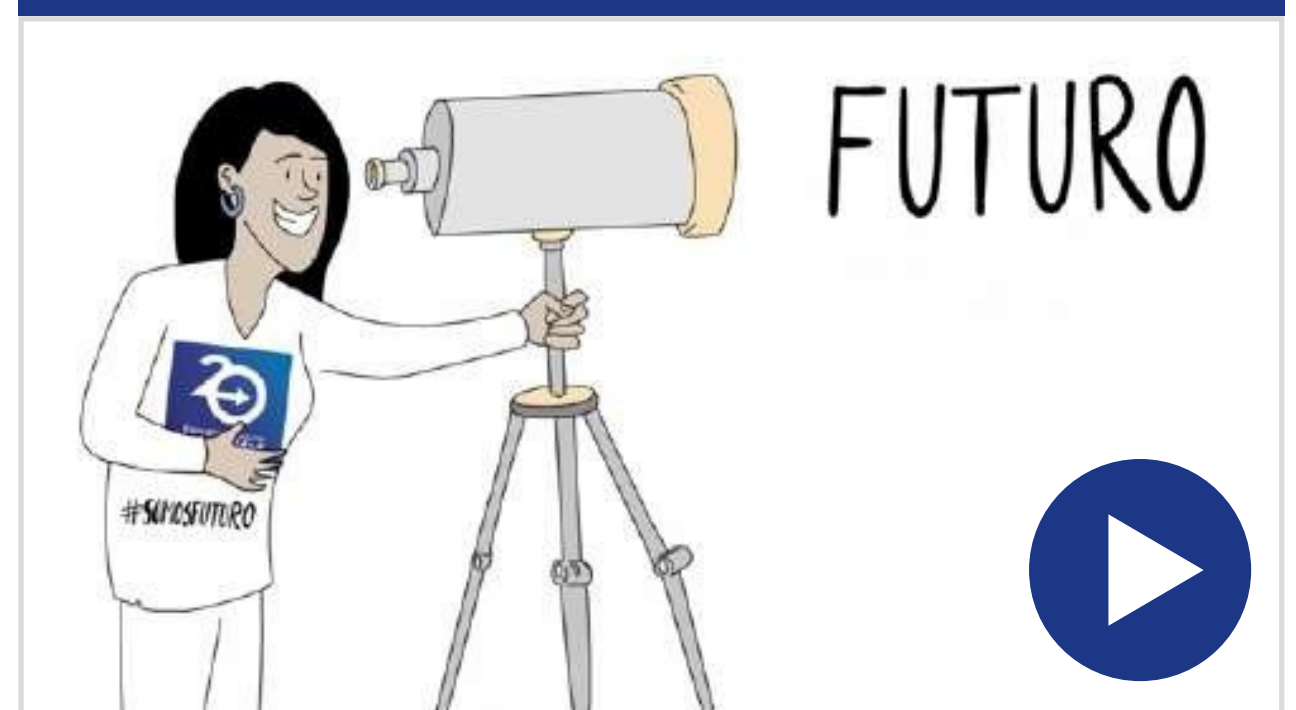
- **We organised the 8th National Meeting of Second Chance Schools under the slogan #SomosFuturo at CaixaForum Madrid on 10 May, together with Fundación Tomillo, Opción 3 Iniciativa Social, La Rueda Asociación, Federación de Plataformas Sociales Pinardi, Asociación Norte Joven and Fundación Empieza por Educar. More than 280 people attended the meeting, including representatives from public administrations, companies, social organisations and universities, as well as young people and educators.**
- **We promoted the E2O Month in five Autonomous Communities, thanks to the collaboration of our member organisations, which organised talks, workshops and other activities to join forces against early school leaving and youth unemployment.**

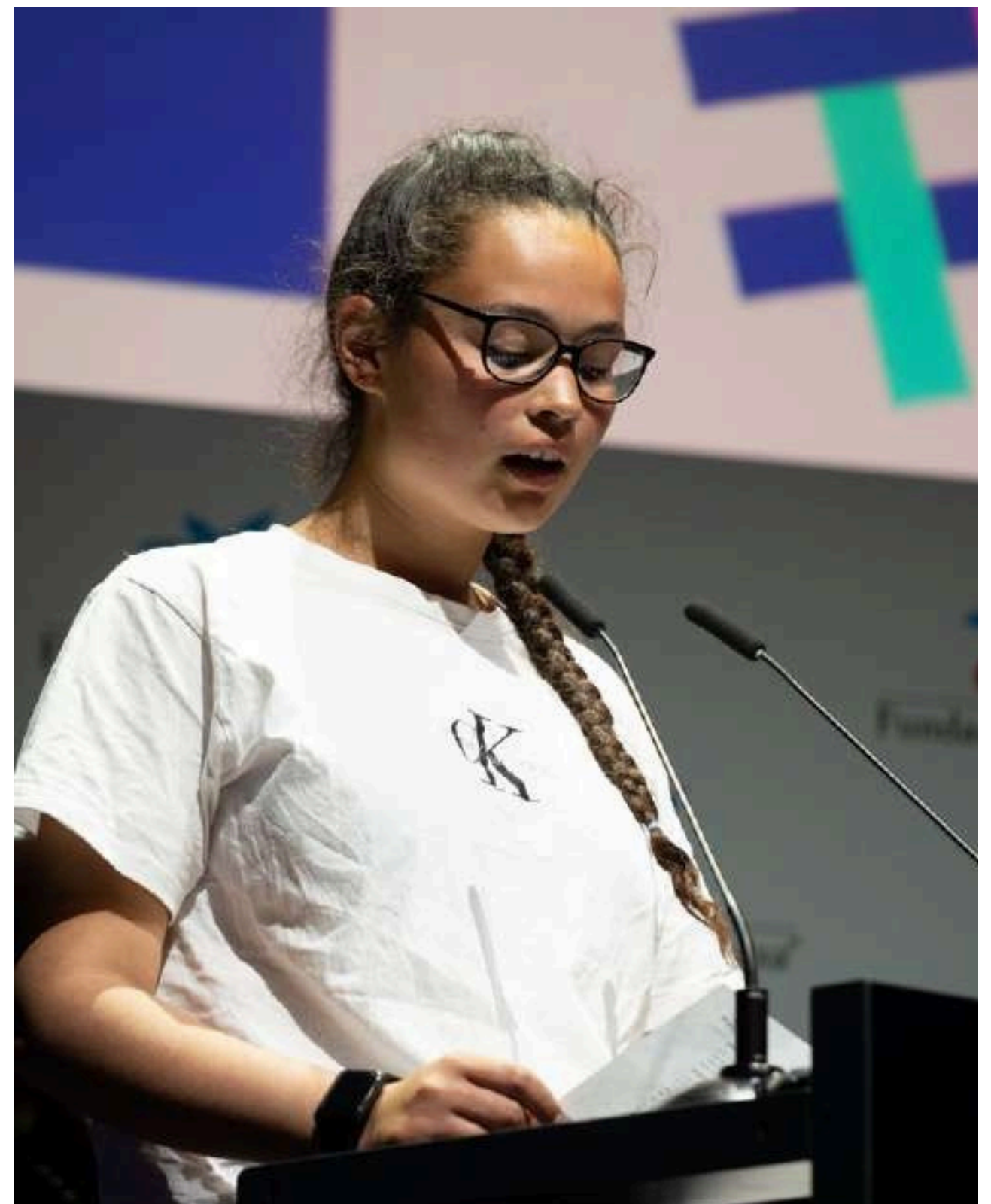
Proyectos

- **Throughout the year, we implemented the second edition of the E2O en Red 2.0 project, funded by the Ministry of Social Rights and the 2030 Agenda, with the aim of improving opportunities for young people in vulnerable situations by strengthening networking at both national and international levels.**

Thanks to this project, we produced a report on the key elements of E2O networks, engaged young people from the schools in awareness-raising activities, and organised the event “Second Chance Schools in Europe: A Transnational Perspective”, focusing on young people’s mobility experiences through Euro-Mediterranean cooperation.

- **We launched the third phase of the project under the title E2O en Red 3.0, focused on developing opportunities for young people in the Euro-Mediterranean context. During this phase, we began designing and structuring the activities planned for 2025.**





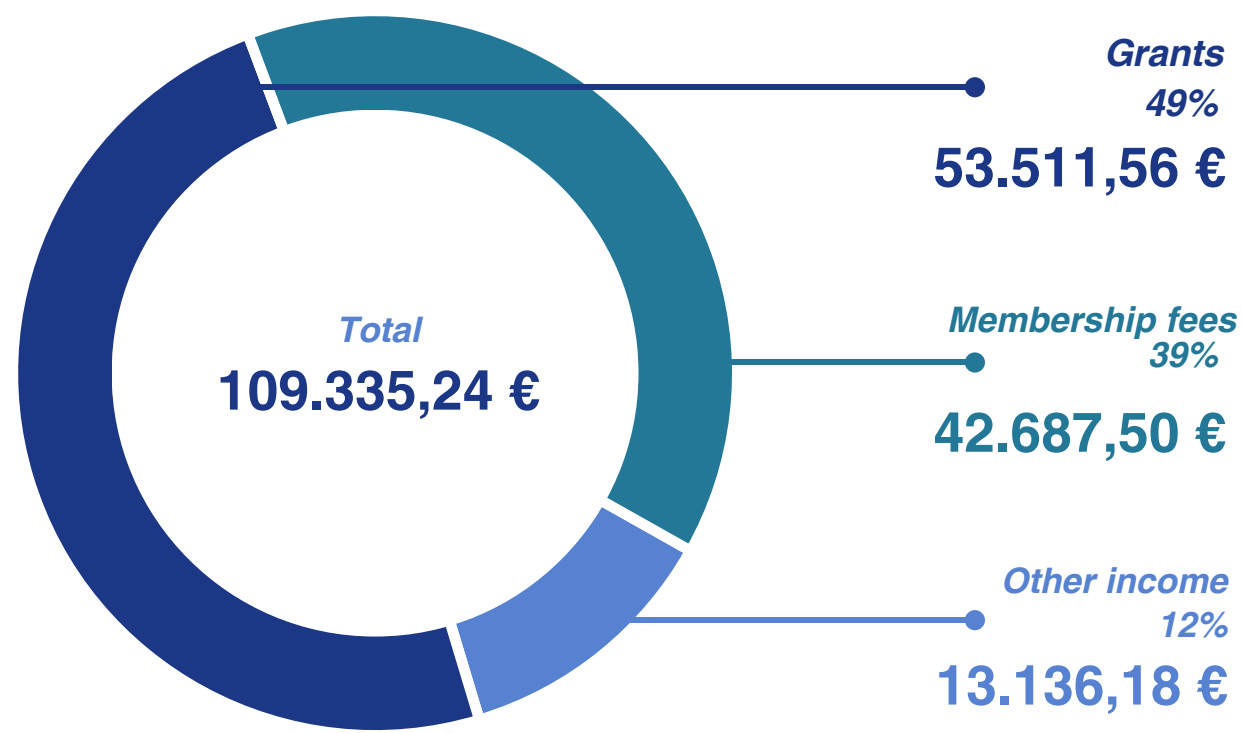
Cooperación

- *We actively collaborate in the design and implementation of the Youth Agora project, promoted by the European Association of Second Chance Schools, whose aim is to strengthen the democratic skills of young people connected to European E2O schools. Within this framework, we organized an information session aimed at Spanish E2O schools and participated, together with the Fundació Gentis, in a preparatory meeting held in Paris in December, focused on defining the first project activities for professionals in the field, which will take place during the first half of 2025.*
- *We attended the Annual Seminar of the Mediterranean New Chance (MedNC) network in October in Rome, where we worked alongside 18 organizations from Europe and the Mediterranean region. The meeting focused on promoting green skills, youth entrepreneurship, and the need to develop innovative training programs to support the socioeconomic inclusion of young people in the region.*
- *We coordinated the participation of four partner organizations from the network (Fundació El Llindar, Fundació Gentis, Fundació Intermedia, and Fundación Somos F5) in the Expert Mission organized by MedNC in Barcelona. This activity enabled the exchange of best practices and methodologies focused on the use of digital technologies to create new professional opportunities for young people in vulnerable situations.*
- *We supported the development of MedNGreen, an innovative educational tool promoted by the MedNC network, aimed at training in green skills and raising awareness about career opportunities linked to the green transition. This tool will soon be available for implementation in the Second Chance Schools that are part of the MedNC network.*

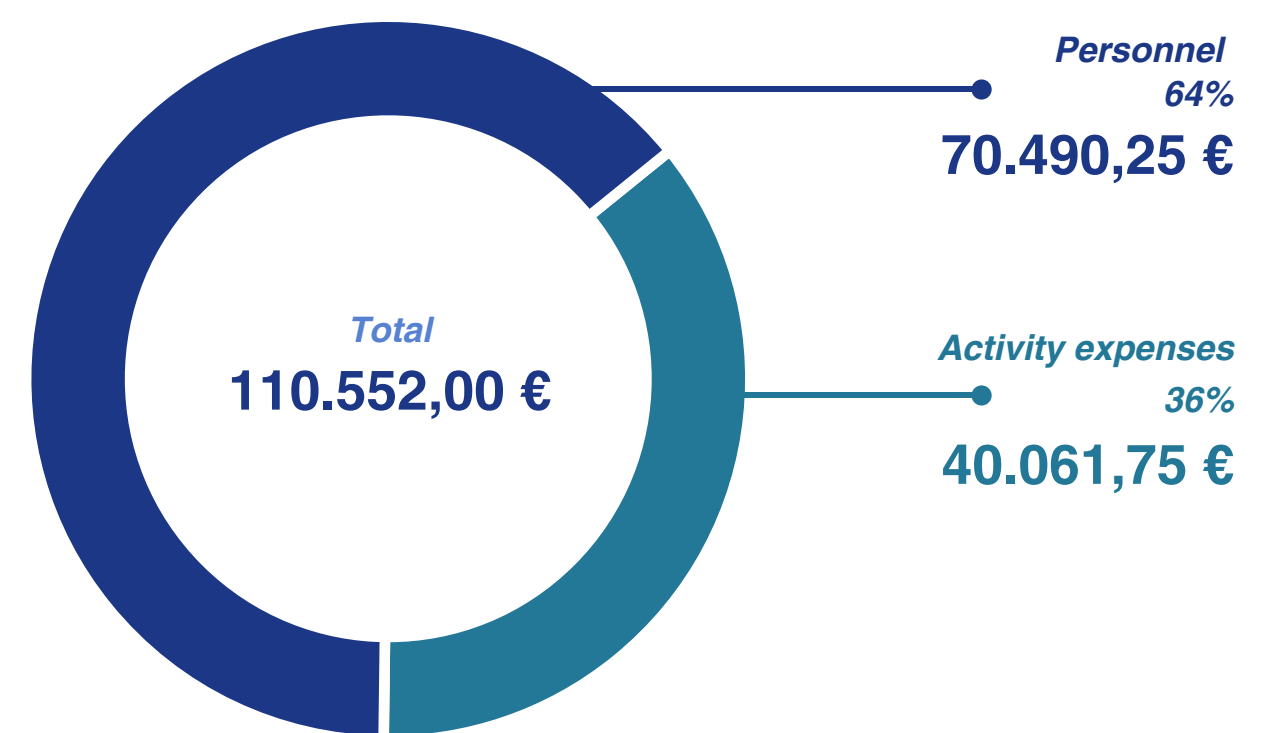
